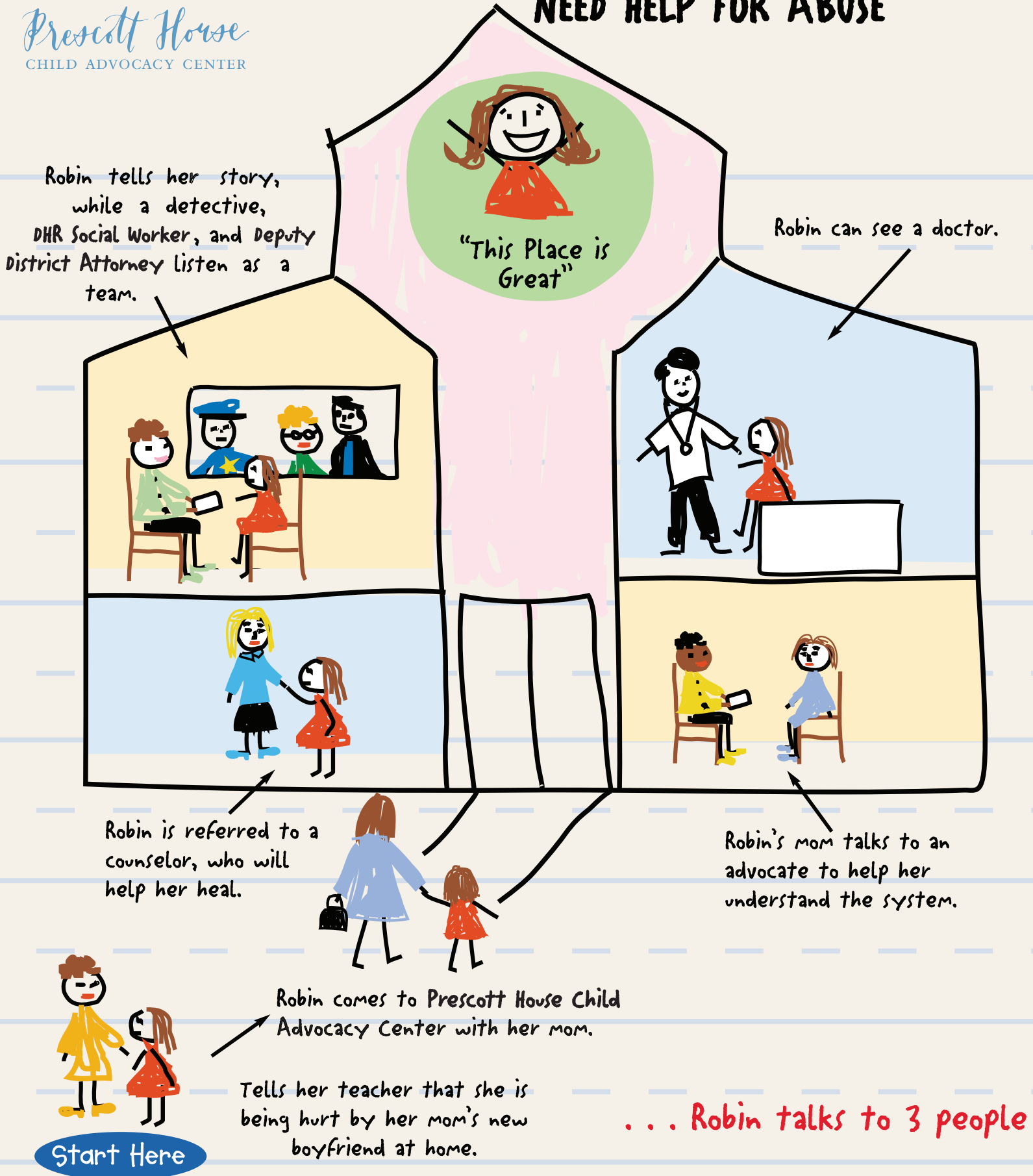

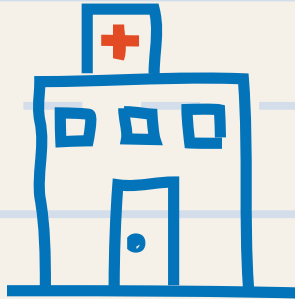

Tells her teacher she is being hurt at home.

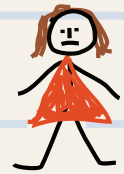


Who talks to Robin?

Doctor

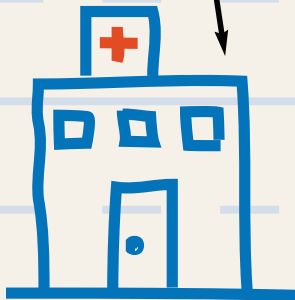


At School...Who talks to Robin?

is examined by another Doctor.
